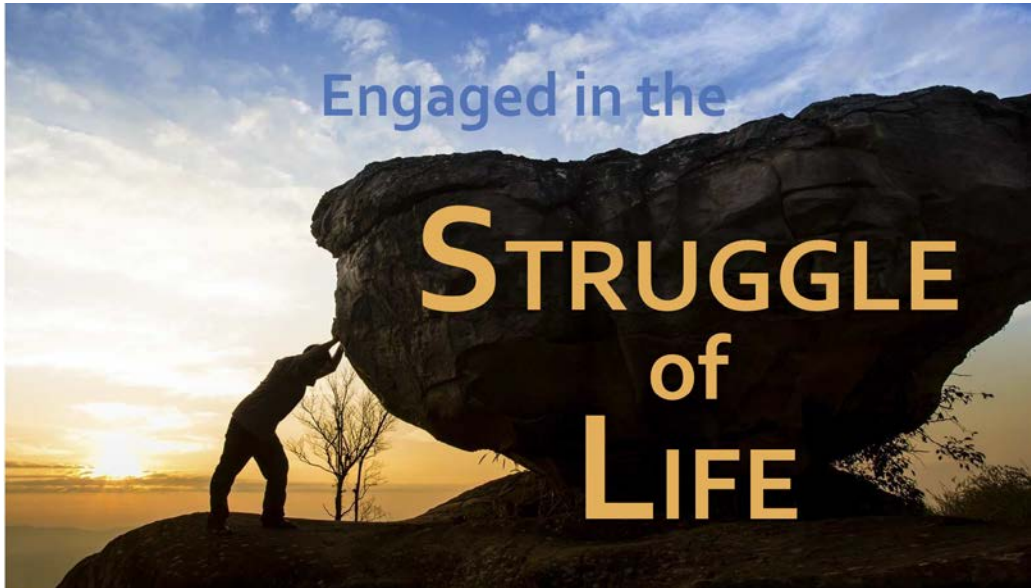

WORSHIP NOTES: This weekend we zero in on the relationship between Father, Son and Holy Spirit – the Holy Trinity. Our Gospel lesson will state clearly from Jesus’ Great Commission that all his work connects us to him and to the three-person-one God. This mystery plays a special part in our understanding of our earthly struggle, as the Apostle Paul tells the Corinthians about the warfare and the weapons of engagement. We are called to fight in a new way, as those who have taken thoughts captive to Christ. Today we begin our Summer Sermon Series, “Engaged in the Struggle of Life.”

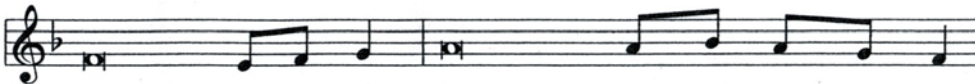

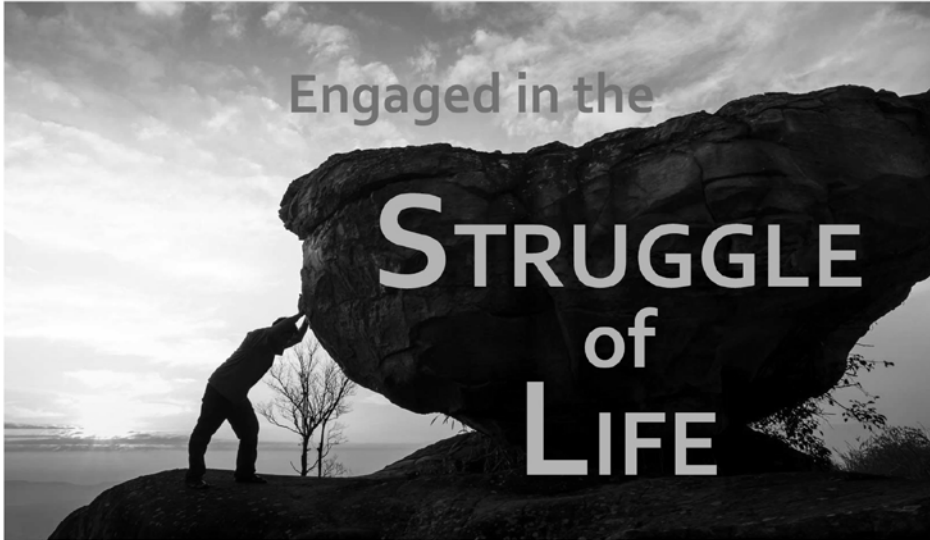

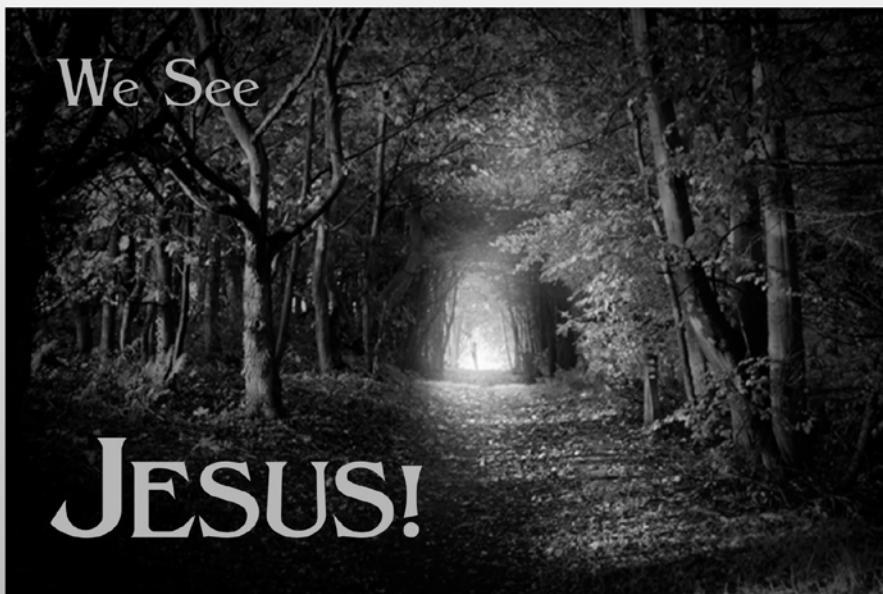
