WORSHIP NOTES Today, we see that respecting God as the Author and Controller of life means not trying to prevent Him from doing what He does – not thinking ourselves above Him – but being willing to let go. This applies well to the topic and concern for life, as the country still seems divided on who counts enough to be cared for.

Introduction: Respect for life appears to be a major issue for Americans, especially when we see how often the elderly and children are killed (as in the Waukesha parade). As a result, life issues are no longer limited to only the abortion topic. Who's life matters and under what conditions? Christians believe that God is the Giver of Life and as a result only his Word can set the boundaries. Today we'll talk about the value of life from 2 Timothy 3 as we listen and learn how God guards us and others. Our service today directs us into the Scripture and to biblically sound resources.

SECOND LESSON 2 Timothy 3:14 – 4:5

But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it, and how from infancy you have known the holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work. In the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who will judge the living and the dead, and in view of his appearing and his kingdom, I give you this charge: Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage--with great patience and careful instruction. For the time will come when men will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear. They will turn their ears away from the truth and turn aside to myths. But you, keep your head in all situations, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, discharge all the duties of your ministry.

GOSPEL Luke 4:38-44

Jesus left the synagogue and went to the home of Simon. Now Simon's mother-in-law was suffering from a high fever, and they asked Jesus to help her. So he bent over her and rebuked the fever, and it left her. She got up at once and began to wait on them. When the sun was setting, the people brought to Jesus all who had various kinds of sickness, and laying his hands on each one, he healed them. Moreover, demons came out of many people, shouting, "You are the Son of God!" But he rebuked them and would not allow them to speak, because they knew he was the Christ. 

Christian Life Resources founded and supports *New Beginnings – A Home for Mothers*, located in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. We opened the doors to *New Beginnings* in October of 1993 to help single mothers and their newborns with spiritual, academic, and vocational assistance in a residential setting. *New Beginnings* also networks with single mothers in the community to provide assistance where possible.




