

Mere Christianity by CS Lewis was originally presented as a series of talks on the BBC during 1940s wartime and later put into print. Lewis was asked to give an explanation as to what it meant to be a "Christian." An important issue he addressed within that overarching topic was how we can live in a world that is often bad – yet have a very good God at the helm. This seeming contention is an argument for atheists, a struggle for agnostics, and yet a reality for Christians. In this study, Lewis' impactful explanation will be examined all through the lens of Scripture. It is as contemporary and relevant now as it was seventy years ago when Lewis' book was published. Even more so, how timeless the truths of the Bible are, thousands of years later!
