



# Confirmation

**May 13, 2023**

*Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.*

Holy Baptism is the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, which God poured out on us abundantly through our Savior, Jesus Christ. Justified by his grace, we have been made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. In this Sacrament our loving God receives little children into his covenant and rule of grace, working faith in them and making them members of the invisible Church and temples of the Holy Spirit.



As our Lord faithfully keeps his covenant of mercy, he also promises those who are his own: "Be faithful to death, and I will give you a crown of life!" To the end that his will might be accomplished and his children may grow in grace and Christian knowledge and wisdom as they advance in years, he commands parents to "bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord." He directs his church to do what he told Peter, "Feed My lambs!"

According to his promise and command, children are instructed in the Christian faith. When they reach an age of discretion and understand God's covenant of grace into which his Spirit called them at the time of their baptism, they promise to daily live according to his will. They do this not because they "have to," but because they want to serve him out of love and thanks. Now able to examine themselves and to recognize our Savior's true body and blood in the Sacrament of Holy Communion, they should also receive this Sacrament often along with their fellow members of the family of faith.



To encourage such growth in Christian knowledge and faith, the rite of **CONFIRMATION** is maintained in the Evangelical Lutheran Church. The catechumens publicly profess their faith in Christ, confirming their covenant with God. Assured that they possess such knowledge of biblical doctrine to warrant the worthy reception of the Lord's Supper, our elders invite them to receive it in true faith. We ask the Holy Spirit through his Gospel in Word and Sacrament to cause them to grow in grace, to remain steadfast and immovable in trusting their Savior's love, to become increasingly fruitful in all good works, and in the end to receive the promised crown of life.

## **THE CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION**

P: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and there is no truth in us. But if we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to purify us from all unrighteousness. In that hope and confidence, let us humbly confess . . .

C: **Lord God, Heavenly Father, I come before your throne and admit my sins. Throughout my life, including this past week, I have been incredibly selfish. The old sinful nature within me judges everything for my own advantage. As a result of my selfishness, I often experience sinful thoughts and desires such as greed, jealousy, covetousness, rebellion, the desire for revenge. And as a result of my sinful thoughts, I often speak and act in ways that hurt and offend you as well as my fellow human beings. Heavenly Father, I know that nothing I do or say can ever earn your forgiveness. Yet I also know that you are a good and gracious God. I know that you sent Jesus to carry my sins, together with the world's sins, on the cross. He died for me! Let me hear your words of forgiveness so that my heart and soul might be reassured. Let me experience the peace and joy of salvation that comes only through faith in Christ.**

P: Dear brothers and sisters in the Lord, I stand before you as God's representative to proclaim to you his love and forgiveness. Jesus kept the law, suffered and died in our place. Out of love, he fully and freely gives to you and to me his righteousness without any merit or worthiness on our part. He says to us:

"Though your sins are like scarlet,  
They shall be as white as snow;  
Though they are red like crimson,  
They shall be like wool." (Is. 1:18)

May God enable us to believe his message with all our hearts, that by the power of the Holy Spirit through the Gospel, it may transform and renew our minds and our lives.

## **WE HEAR THE WORD FROM THE FIRST LESSON** Ecclesiastes 5:1-7

Guard your steps when you go to the house of God. Go near to listen rather than to offer the sacrifice of fools, who do not know that they do wrong.

Do not be quick with your mouth,  
do not be hasty in your heart

to utter anything before God.  
God is in heaven  
and you are on earth,  
so let your words be few.

A dream comes when there are many cares,  
and many words mark the speech of a fool.

When you make a vow to God, do not delay to fulfill it. He has no pleasure in fools; fulfill your vow. It is better not to make a vow than to make one and not fulfill it. Do not let your mouth lead you into sin. And do not protest to the temple messenger, "My vow was a mistake." Why should God be angry at what you say and destroy the work of your hands? Much dreaming and many words are meaningless. Therefore fear God.

## **SECOND LESSON** 2 Timothy 3:10-17

You, however, know all about my teaching, my way of life, my purpose, faith, patience, love, endurance, persecutions, sufferings—what kinds of things happened to me in Antioch, Iconium and Lystra, the persecutions I endured. Yet the Lord rescued me from all of them. In fact, everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted, while evildoers and impostors will go from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived. But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it, and how from infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

## **GOSPEL LESSON** Matthew 10:32-39

"Whoever acknowledges me before others, I will also acknowledge before my Father in heaven. But whoever disowns me before others, I will disown before my Father in heaven.

"Do not suppose that I have come to bring peace to the earth. I did not come to bring peace, but a sword. For I have come to turn

" 'a man against his father,  
a daughter against her mother,  
a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law—  
a man's enemies will be the members of his own household.'

"Anyone who loves their father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; anyone who loves their son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. Whoever does not take up their cross and follow me is not worthy of me. Whoever finds their life will lose it, and whoever loses their life for my sake will find it.

## CONFESSION OF FAITH

**C:** I believe that I cannot by my own thinking or choosing believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, or come to him. But the Holy Spirit has called me by the Gospel, enlightened me with his gifts, sanctified and kept me in the true faith. In the same way he calls, gathers, enlightens and sanctifies the whole Christian church on earth, and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the one true faith. In this Christian church he daily and fully forgives all sins to me and all believers. On the Last Day he will raise me and all the dead; and he will give eternal life to me and all believers in Christ. This is most certainly true.

## RITE OF CONFIRMATION

You are here to make a public profession of your Christian faith. The Apostle Paul writing to the Romans says: "If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved ... For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved. Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

Therefore, lift up your hearts to the God of all grace and joyfully answer these questions:

**P:** Do you this day in the presence of God and of this congregation acknowledge that in Baptism, God gave you the forgiveness of sins, life, and salvation?

**C:** **I do.**

**P:** Do you reject the devil along with all his lies and empty promises?

**C:** **I do.**

**P:** Do you believe in God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit?

**C:** **I believe in God, the Father almighty,  
maker of heaven and earth.**

**I believe in Jesus Christ, his only son, our Lord,  
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,  
born of the virgin Mary,  
suffered under Pontius Pilate,  
was crucified, died, and was buried.  
He descended into hell.  
The third day he rose again from the dead.  
He ascended into heaven  
and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty.  
From there he will come to judge the living and the dead.**

**I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church  
the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins,  
the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen**

**P:** Do you believe all the books of the Bible to be the inspired Word of God?

**C:** **I do.**

**P:** Do you believe that the teaching of the Evangelical Lutheran Church, as you have learned to know it from Luther's Small Catechism, is faithful and true to the Word of God?

**C:** **I do.**

**P:** Do you intend to continue steadfast in this teaching and to endure all things, even death, rather than fall away from it?

**C:** **I do, by the grace of God.**

**P:** Do you intend faithfully to conform all your life to the teachings of God's Word; to be faithful in the use of the Word and Sacrament; and in faith and action remain true to God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, as long as you live?

**C:** **I do, and I ask God to help me.**

**P:** Since it is God alone who enables us both to will and to do his good pleasure, it is right for us, dear friends in Christ, to call on him for *these confirmans*, that he would graciously complete the good work which he has begun in *them*. Let us, therefore, bow our heads and pray.

**P:** Lord Jesus, Author and Perfecter of our faith, in mercy you joined *these brothers and sisters* to your Church when *they* were born again of water and the Spirit. In mercy you taught *them* your saving truth. Grant that *they* may offer themselves as living sacrifices to you as *their* spiritual act of worship. Transform *them* by the renewing of *their* minds so that they will not conform to the pattern of this world. Help us live in love and harmony with one another, and work together in serving you.

Keep us united in your Spirit and bring us at last to your eternal kingdom where you live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.

**C: Amen.**

P: Do you intend to bring them regularly to worship services and have them participate in Bible Study, both in the congregational life and their own personal lives?

**ANS: I do.**

P: Do you intend to encourage them to serve their Lord Jesus throughout their lives in everything they do, especially throughout their lives in their Christian congregation?

P: Do you intend to be an example for them of such a Christian life and lifestyle by how you live and how you speak?

ANS: I do so intend to do all these things, with the help of God and by his grace.

P: We ask that God would forgive our sins as we forgive those who sin against us so that our hearts may rest and rejoice in a good conscience before him, and that no sin may ever frighten or alarm us.

**C: Forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who sin against us.**

P: We pray that God would protect us from all temptations and help us by his Spirit to put down our sinful flesh, to despise the world and its vices, and to overcome the devil and all his trickery.

**C: Lead us not into temptation.**

P: And finally, we pray that God would deliver us from all evils of body and soul now and forever.

**C: But deliver us from evil.**

P: All those who sincerely desire these things will say from their hearts "Amen," trusting without doubt that their prayers are answered in heaven, as Christ has promised: "Whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours."


