



<sup>7</sup>Then I said, 'Here I am—it is written about me in the scroll—I have come to do your will, my God.' "

<sup>8</sup>First he said, "Sacrifices and offerings, burnt offerings and sin offerings you did not desire, nor were you pleased with them"—though they were offered in accordance with the law. <sup>9</sup>Then he said, "Here I am, I have come to do your will."
