## **Stewardship from God's Word:** 2 Corinthians 12:7b-10

Sometimes God adds by taking things away. This equation seems painful for us, but God always has a purpose. He increased Paul's reliance on him by taking away physical comfort. We can't always understand why God allows us to experience losses in our lives: money, possessions, health, loved ones, and even our lives. But we know that the Lord is constantly calling us to rely on him more fully and to trust him more deeply. Faith in Jesus is leaning solely on his love and depending on his power alone.






As baptized children of God, we confess our sins.

CW 680 vs 3




Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

#### **Words of Institution**


